Call # 16-17194, Scam by Phone report, Summary:

On 10/01/16 at approximately 0842 hours, a complainant from Founder Road reported a possible scam. She received a disturbing text message on her phone that was from the number of 415-236-5502. This number is to a spoof pre-paid phone. The complainant recognized this was a possible scam and deleted the message.

On 10/05/16 at approximately 1031 hours, a complainant from Glenwood Road reported a possible scam. He was selling a product on Craigs list and the buyer wanted to pay over twice the amount for the item with a check. The complainant recognized this as a scam and did not deposit the check which was not a valid one.
